SYRINGE DRIVER COMPETENCY PROGRAMME

The Hospice New Zealand Syringe Driver Competency Programme is for registered and enrolled nurses and develops the knowledge and skills required to manage subcutaneous infusions using the Niki T34 / Bodyguard T syringe driver.

Initial certification provides 4 hours of professional development and involves completion of pre-reading, attendance at a two-hour workshop, demonstration of practical competence and completion of a written test. Certification is maintained by attending periodic updates.

FOUNDATIONS IN PALLIATIVE CARE

- Pain and Symptom Management
- Care in the Last Days of Life
- Communication and Goals of Care
- Grief, Loss and Bereavement Support
- Spiritual Care

PALLIATIVE CARE FOR CAREGIVERS

This Hospice New Zealand education resource is an alternative to Fundamentals of Palliative Care and helps caregivers, working in all care settings, explore their role in providing palliative care.

The course consists of four 90-minute seminars and is usually delivered on site to a group of 10 -15 caregivers. There is a small cost for the course workbook.
